Thank you for your support and attendance at these important meetings this week. Also, your feedback to governors was really helpful. Pencil Cases and other items:

Please can we kindly ask you <u>not</u> to provide your child with a pencil case or any stationery items for school. We provide all of these for the children and, as a result, they are all exactly the same. You wouldn't believe the amount of time and upset this saves in class. Thank you so much for your support. The same is also true of jewellery (bracelets/necklaces), temporary tattoos, nail varnish, even 'fashion' shoes and boots - please support us by adhering to our uniform policy as it causes so much upset and wasted time. Safe arrival and departure:

Please be aware that all children need to be walked to/collected from their **classroom doors or**The Aviary doors by an adult (over 16) please. This enables one adult to 'handover' to another and ensure the safe arrival and departure of all our children. Thank you for your support.

School meal prices:

I am really sorry to say that we will have to increase school meal prices to £2.60 from 1st April 2025 (from £2.50). You will be aware of the increase in employers NI/the living wage and the ever increasing food prices. Sadly, we are not immune to these pressures. As you know, all children in Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 are able to have school meals for free. These year groups are unaffected. We apologise for this rise, but it is totally unavoidable. Thank you for your understanding.

Volunteering at Russell:

As you know, to volunteer at Russell all adults are required to attend a short 'induction' and undertake a DBS check. This ensures that all our volunteers are safe adults to be around our children. This costs over £50 per volunteer. We will willingly pay for this but do request that you then 'use' this to do at least some volunteering in school. Thank you for your support.

Russell Snack Policy:

Please be reminded that our snack policy is that children may bring in one snack from home a day: this is either chopped fruit or vegetables, or cheese (on its own). Again, this keeps everyone the same and minimises disruption and upset. Thank you

Russell Lower School Values:
