The term honesty means to tell the truth. To be truthful is to tell someone exactly what happened or was said.


If you show the value honesty it means you are someone we can trust and believe in what you say.

- ▶ You explain how a situation really happened. You are not being honest if you only tell one side of the story to stop yourself or someone else from getting into trouble.
