



Due to the demands on our service ever increasing, we are asking for your help. We have set ourselves a target to collect 30,000 tins, which will help us restock and help us prepare for Christmas which is alway very busy. We have noticed a massive increase in food parcels over the last year. In July 2024, we provided 769 parcel and 401 bags of best before food. This is a 90% increase on July 2023 in food parcels.
