Learning should be fun and is for life. Using our knowledge of the individual child and how they learn, we ensure that excellence is achieved through enjoyment of the curriculum and all the activities we provide.

Children are encouraged to explore, question and take ownership of their learning. They spend time discussing and assessing their own and others' work, striving to do better and to understand what they need to learn next in order to achieve their full potential. Our results at Foundation Stage, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 are consistently above the national and county average.

We believe children flourish within a broad and balanced thematic curriculum.

We provide regular enrichment 'wow' days when we explore different subjects of the curriculum in depth, such as Year 1's visit from Sir Teachalot, Year 4's visit from an Egyptian Archaeologist or Year 2's Teaching Talons. We also have regular trips out such as Year 1's trip to Whipsnade, Year 3's visits to the National Space Centre and Polar Explorers' Museum in Cambridge, or Year 2's seaside trip to Great Yarmouth! These days are an opportunity to extend the pupils' knowledge and understanding whilst focusing on a particular subject.

Following a £3.9m investment in 2015/16, our facilities include a state-of-the-art IT suite, interactive 'Clevertouch' boards in all classes, a well-stocked library, three playgrounds (with age-appropriate trim-trails), a wildlife garden and pond, play equipment and extensive playing fields. We have an impressive range of after-school activities and clubs that include competitive sports eg. Football, tag rugby, archery and fencing as well as a choir, gardening club, Science club and Art Adventurers club.

In addition, we also provide wrap around care between 7:45am and 6pm in our thriving 'Before and After School Club' which provides quality care for our children and also their siblings from Alameda Middle School.

In addition to the National Curriculum, children are given many diverse opportunities to develop their passions and enrich their learning.

Children benefit from the expertise of our sports coaches who come in to share their skills each week and regularly take part in sporting events and festivals enjoying the teamwork and challenge this provides. This includes working with Redborne Upper School Sports Partnership to ensure the children receive expert sports coaching and opportunities.

Children take part in musical and drama productions and concerts during the year and a significant number of children learn to play a musical instrument such as the viola, violin, piano, flute, guitar, drums and brass instruments. There are regular trips to the theatre, local places of interest in Ampthill and beyond and museums or galleries which further enhance the children's learning and understanding of the world. In addition, we offer a Year 4 Residential Visit to enable the children to experience an overnight stay away from home.

We have an extremely active, supportive and successful PTA who run fun fundraising events. Recent events include a Winter Ball, Christmas Fair, Children's Discos, Big Top Circus and Quiz Nights to name but a few.

We have a skilled, supportive and highly effective Governing Board and Parent Governor Forum which works closely with the leadership of the school to provide the very best education and experiences for the children.

Russell Lower School prides itself in being at the heart of the Ampthill community, participating in St Andrew's Christmas Tree Festival, attending Remembrance Day Services, hosting Open the Book assemblies and joining in with the Gala Weekend Festivities and parade.
