This term, we're delighted that your child is receiving cricket coaching at school through our 'Chance to Shine' scheme.

We think sport, and cricket in particular, can offer children so much, such as leadership, learning how to work in a team, how to win and to lose graciously; not to mention all the health benefits.

Ten years ago, there's a good chance that your child wouldn't have had the opportunity to play cricket at school. The game was dying out, with less than 10 per cent of state schools playing competitive cricket.

That's why we launched Chance to Shine. We link local cricket clubs to schools and pay for professional coaches to take weekly cricket sessions, all for free. And your child is now one of two million children to play and learn through cricket, thanks to Chance to Shine.
